## BOOK EURO 2020 WITH NCT

We are happy to announce that the city of **St. Petersburg will host seven matches of the upcoming European Football Championship**, which will take place from June 11 to July 11 across eleven European cities. Namely those will be: six B and E group matches and one quarter-final.

Another reason for many of us to rejoice is that **Foreign fans will be able to come to Russia for the European Football Championship without a Visa!**

This was reported by the press service of the organizing committee of the Russian part of the European Championship.

Entry to Russia will be granted to all foreign citizens including stateless persons who have tickets for Euro 2020, its Organizing Committee's press service told Interfax.

"In the current difficult conditions, the movement of people has been seriously reduced," said Alexei Sorokin, director of the Euro 2020 Organizing Committee.

"With the federal authorities' understanding, we're able to open the border for those who are going to visit us in St. Petersburg for a football holiday in the summer."

"At the same time, it is very important to understand that we intend to hold the safest tournament possible - permission to enter Russia does not cancel the rules and measures that must be observed on the territory of Russia: in particular, a negative PCR test and so on," he stressed.

With a FAN-ID, foreigners can cross the border many times from May 29 to July 12, 2021 (fan-id.ru).

Other documents required for entry to Russia include:

- 1) Passport
- 2) Medical Insurance
- 3) Certificate confirming negative COVID-19 test result (test conducted no earlier than three calendar days before arrival in the Russian Federation).

June 23, 19:00 local time - SWEDEN - POLAND  
July 02, 19:00 local time - 1/4 finals
